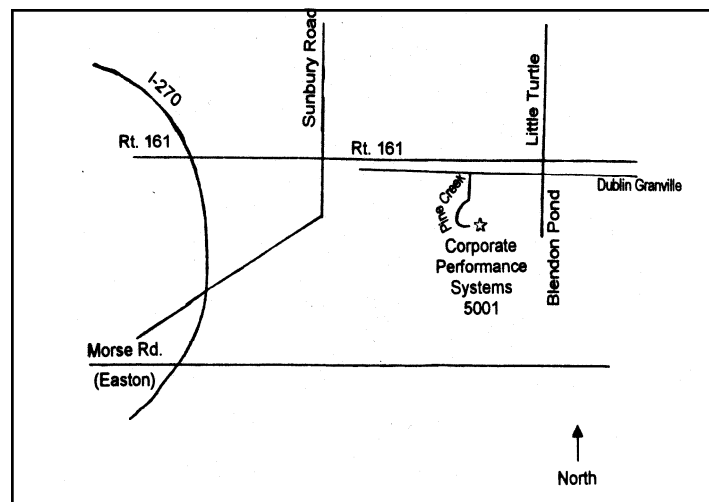

Vicki Milliron called the meeting to order. She reported that Mary Saint was in the hospital. Minutes were approved.

Vicki shared news of the Mid-Ohio Classic. The prize list is done. We're going to stop giving high-point awards because many winners have already left by the end of the show when they are awarded. Mailing has been a problem. We will have several of the custom MODA lead shanks as raffle items.

The treasurer, Randy, reported that the balance is \$1297.59 in MODA's checking account.

Nancy, Amy, and Vicki were at a clinic at Dancing Horse Farm in Lebanon <<http://www.dancinghorsefarmoh.com/>> and really liked the facilities. They would like to approach the owner, Jennifer Truett about holding the USDF 2008 adult clinic with Jane Savoie there. We'll probably get more auditors.

The group brainstormed ideas for fun and educational MODA events. Vicki suggested holding a series of grass-roots junior rider workshops with Ellie Spellerberg at Amy's and/or Dee's on the first Saturday afternoons of June, July, and August. The workshops would be educational and would work on Training level 1 and 2. The board empowered Vicki to organize the series. Vicki also suggested a late fall or winter biomechanics workshop with Nancy Nicholson <<http://nicholn1.wcp.muohio.edu/>>. Other suggestions included potlucks, "Dressage 101," "Horse Management 101," equine nutrition, hoofcare, equine dentistry, pasture management, and alternative medicine educational sessions. Please contact your board with your suggestions.

Nancy and Randy reported that MODA currently has 120 members, and we anticipate approximately ten more to sign up during show season. This is about where we were this time last year.

Nancy reported progress on editing the MODA directory policies to be in agreement with USEF and USDF policies and to better reflect current MODA procedures. She and Carrie have been working on the awards update. Word-smithing ensued.

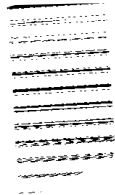
