Horse Apparel/Needs

- 2 halters
- Lead ropes
- Chain
- Head bumper
- Shipping boots or leg bandages & wraps
- Bell boots
- Travel sheet, rug
- Tail bandage
- Cooler
- First aid kit

Grooming

- Tote with brushes, hoof picks, etc.
- Shampoo
- Washing buckets

- Fly spray
- Hoof oil/polish
- Show Sheen
- Mane pulling comb

- Full hay net for trailer

- Stirrup irons

- Breeches
- Belt

- Boot pulls
- Boot jack
- Spurs and straps
- Shirts
- Riding underwear
- Sports bra
- Socks
- Jacket
- Stock tie and pins
- Helmet/hat
- Gloves
- Dressage whip
- Rain gear
- Toiletries
- Towels
